### 4. Matters Arising

**Fundraising**: CB requested list of equipment from practice that PPG may be able to raise funding for. PC will update but informed the meeting that they are trying to get funding from other sources.

- 5. **PCN representative** SH agreed to be the new PCN representative for the PPG in place of LS
- 6. Practice Update PC
  - a) Vaccination timetable: 12 week timetable, using same venue for 2<sup>nd</sup> dose at Brierley Hill
    - 5,335 patients have received the first dose
    - Over 50s and 2<sup>nd</sup> doses now being done
    - Practice contacting patients for 2<sup>nd</sup> dose by text and phone
  - b) Telephone system: Faults and delays still being reported by patients. Calls disconnect after a certain time. System may get overloaded. Action: PC will look into technical difficulties and report back
  - c) Bereavement support: Bereavement card and letter sent to patients' families/next of kin. Practice staff trained to signpost patients to bereavement and support services.
     Dr West has made up a bereavement pack to pass on to other GP practices Action:
     LS will chase up with CCG
  - **d)** Face to face appointments: telephone appointments preferred first step to keep footfall down and results in patients being seen quicker by GPs.
  - e) Staffing: Nursing team fully staffed; GP Partnership changes with Dr Uppal and Dr Harrison being made GP Partners; Denise Vaughan appointed as Team Manager; PC leaving the practice on 22<sup>nd</sup> April to work in Solihull, a new practice manager will be appointed in due course; Jon in ICT will update the website and add any items such as PPG minutes to the site

#### 7. POPS feedback - IA

IA attended online meeting. There was a report from Primary Care Commissioning Manager which highlighted some of the difficulties moving forward
